### Special Events/Projects/ Shifts for all activities are 2-hours, unless otherwise noted.

1-Pt: Non-Interclub visit to another Kiwanis club
1-Pt: Any GRK Committee Meeting ( <i>i.e. Adopt-a-Spot</i> )
1-Pt: Per \$25 in Kind or Cash Donation
2-Pts: Volunteering at a charity organization that has provided speaker in the last 12 months
5-Pts: Volunteering for Easter Seals working 4-H County Fair or volunteering at Community One
5-Pts: Per shift working for another Southwind Kiwanis Club's fund-raising event
5-Pts: Per shift working the Special Olympics Bowling, Fantasy of Lights, Tri-State Food Bank, or Salvation Bells
5-Pts: Any member who is the program speaker at a regularly scheduled GRK meeting and except Committee Chairs
5-Pts: Attending annual regularly scheduled Southwind Division Meeting.
5-Pts: Attending/Preparing a Dream Center meal or volunteering at another Dream Center event.
5-Pts: Per Red Cross blood donation and/or recruiting a non-Kiwanian to donate
5-Pts: Santa Clothes Auctionaire
5 Pts: Volunteer at community event (UE, Wesselman Woods, etc...) per 2 hour shift
10-Pts: Team who secures and coordinates a speaker for GRK Meeting
10-Pts: Attending any sponsored Kiwanis Division/State or international event, except Division Council

**Team points** - Teams receive 10 points total for bringing donuts for the month and facilitating Happy Dollars.

### Year-End Team Bonuses

25-Pts: Attending 45+ GRK weekly meetings (no make-ups or substitutions allowed)
50-Pts: Any team that has a net gain of 2 members in the Kiwanis calendar year.
50-Pts: Visit all 6 Kiwanis Clubs, Circle K, and Key Clubs in the original Southwind Division in the Kiwanis calendar year.
15-Pts: Visit all 3 clubs added to our Division (Princeton, Vincennes and Petersburg) in the Kiwanis calendar year.

### GRK Point Turn In Protocols

\*All Points, with the only exceptions being weekly attendance, Poinsettia activity, Riley Walk and Riley Golf Outing will be reported by the Team Captain or Recorder by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the following month or they will **NOT be counted**.

\*All Points must be submitted using the Club Point form which can be found on the website ([www.greenriverkiwanis.org](http://www.greenriverkiwanis.org))

Chairpersons or Coordinators in charge of an event such as Rib & Tenderloin Sales, BUG and Special Olympics, must turn in participation sheet demonstrating who participated to the Team Recorders. Team Recorders will then be responsible for submitting the assigned points for their respective team points to the Point Czar

Any GRK Member may submit a request in writing to any member of the Points Committee (comprised of the Immediate Past President, President and President Elect) for the assignment of point(s) to an event or activity for the next Kiwanis Year. New point assignments to events or activities **will only be assigned prospectively** for the next Kiwanis Year, **not retrospectively**. The request will be considered at the end of the year September GRK Board Meeting. Merits of the request will be based on the following guidelines:

- How does the event or activity benefit Green River Kiwanis?
- How does the event or activity benefit our Community?
- How does the event or activity benefit the Children we have pledged to serve?
